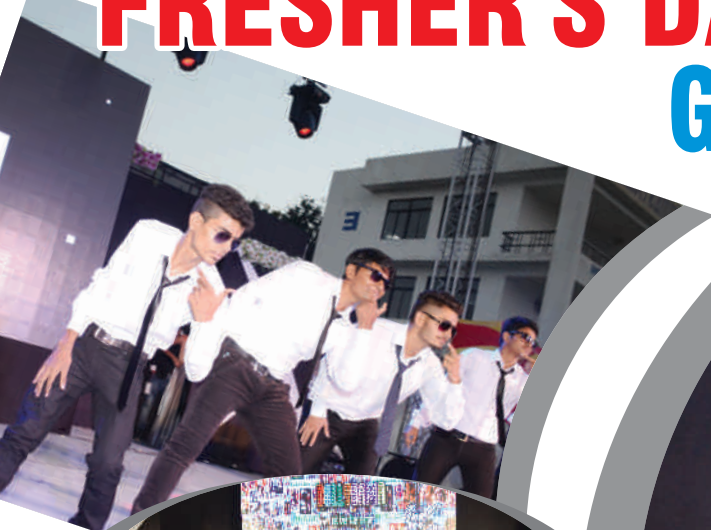
'GLITTERATI' 2016
