


## ACTION TAKEN REPORT

### FOR

### DECISIONS TAKEN IN IQAC MEETING HELD ON 1-12-20

1. Every department organised at least two interactions with the alumni for the students of the department. Also feedbacks were taken from the alumni about the program effectiveness.
2. Dr. Mayank Patel, HOD of Computer Science Engineering department organised several classes on Saturdays during December and January on MS Office with larger focus on Excel for computations.
3. (a) Every department including I Yr prepared the FAQ containing answers and distributed to the final year students and also to students passed out in 2020.  
(b) CDC organised trainings and mock interviews on regular basis. The trainings covered communication, personality development, aptitude and technical skills. The benefits of these were reflected in the student's performance in many interviews.
4. Dr. S. Jindal and HODs of all departments advised the faculty members for increasing the use of ICT in teaching and to demonstrate the application of theory in real life through laboratory experiments and model studies. Extra reading material including e-books is being suggested by teachers to students.
5. Many faculty members and students are enrolled in various online courses and making use of these e-resources in self-learning.
6. Final year students were motivated to take GATE exam. Total 73 students enrolled in GATE training provided by RTU. GATE training platform 'GATEtutor' has been subscribed and all the faculty and students were enrolled for free access through institutional login. This year 3 students could qualify the GATE exam.
7. An Entrepreneurship & Innovation Club has been formed with membership open to all students. Information regarding various competitions and hackathons circulated to students through social media platforms. Students participated in SIH-2020 and won first prize in Hardware category, won first prize in Agri-hackathon and participated and won appreciation in many more competitions. Many students from I Yr class submitted ideas in the Toycathon organised by GOI. 5 proposals were submitted for Chaatra Vishwakarma Award. The members of winning SIH team were asked to mentor the junior students and help in developing an eco-system for innovations and entrepreneurship in the institute.
8. Few proposals were prepared for research grant but could not be submitted due to non-eligibility. However one MODROBs project was submitted by ECE department and more proposals are being prepared for forthcoming session.
9. MoUs with Wipro and Thermax were re-mobilised. Wipro GE executives visited the institute and scheduled to start the training just after the university examination. Thermax has also initiated the process by asking for intending students list.
10. The annual subscription for indexed e-journals has been initiated for IE (I) and scopus/web of science indexed ones in each discipline in addition to regular subscription for DELNET, J-Gate, EdX, NPTEL and Coursera. The faculty were also asked to submit the list of good books from renowned authors for purchase in the library.

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
