Report on Free Eye Check-up Camp Organized in Association with GMCH and GITS

A Free Eye Check-up Camp was successfully organized for female students and faculty members in collaboration with **Geetanjali Medical College & Hospital (GMCH)** and **Geetanjali Institute of Technical Studies (GITS)**. The event took place on 9th April 2024, within the GITS campus premises.

Objective:

The primary aim of the camp was to spread awareness about eye health and provide early detection and diagnosis of common eye problems among women, who often overlook regular health check-ups due to their busy schedules.

Participants:

- Beneficiaries: Over 250 female students and faculty members availed of the facility.
- **Medical Team:** A dedicated team of ophthalmologists and paramedical staff from GMCH conducted comprehensive eye examinations.
- Volunteers: Student volunteers from GITS assisted in smooth coordination of the camp.





Services Offered:

- Vision testing
- Eye pressure measurement
- Screening for common issues such as myopia, hypermetropia, astigmatism, dry eyes, and cataracts

Consultation and expert advice for further treatment if required

Outcome:

The camp witnessed enthusiastic participation and proved to be highly beneficial. Several individuals were advised to undergo further detailed examination, while many received useful eye care tips. Spectacle prescriptions were provided on the spot where needed.
