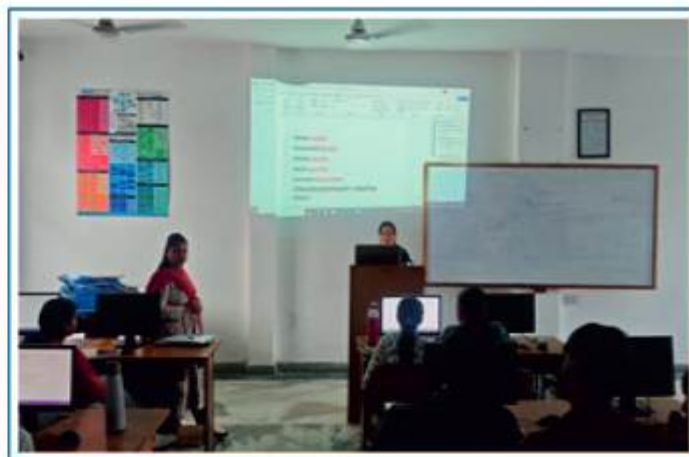

VALUE ADDED TRAINING >>

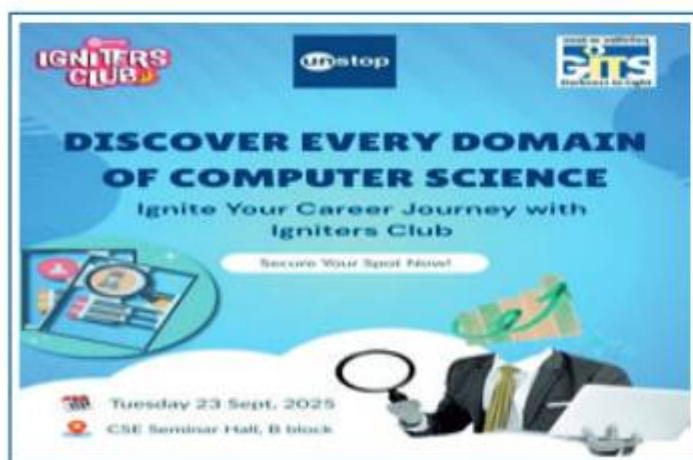

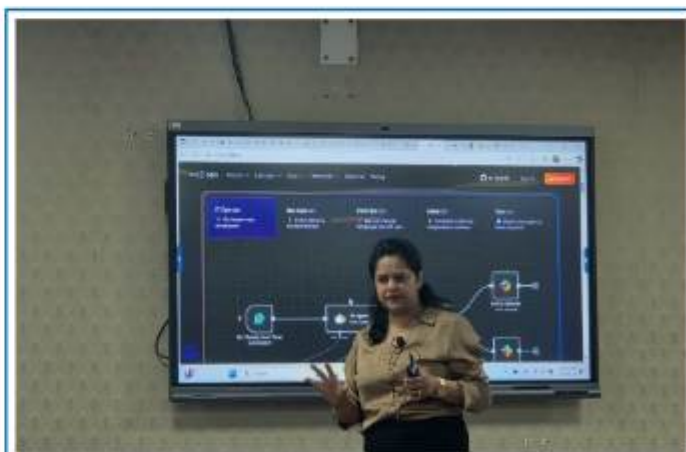

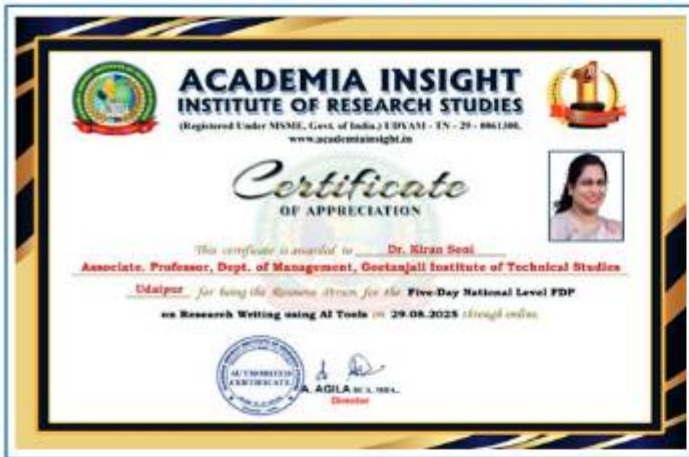

उदयपुर। गौतमजी इंस्टिट्यूट ऑफ टेक्निकल स्टडीज उदयपुर से वर्ष 2008 में पासआउट कंप्यूटर साइंस एंड इंजीनियरिंग की होनहार छात्रा डॉ निलाक्षी जैन ने उच्च शिक्षा और तकनीकी क्षेत्र में अपने योगदान से देशभर में एक अलग पहचान बनाई है। इसके लिए राष्ट्रपति द्रौपदी मुर्मू ने उन्हें विशेष सम्मान प्रदान किया।

संस्थान के निदेशक डॉ एसएम प्रसादकुमार ने बताया कि वर्ष 2008 में पासआउट डॉ निलाक्षी मुर्मु के शाह एंड एंकर कुच्छे इंजीनियरिंग कॉलेज में साइबर सुरक्षा विभाग की प्रमुख हैं और उनको शिक्षण और शोध का 17 वर्षों से अधिक अनुभव है। राष्ट्रपति ने उच्च शिक्षा, तकनीकी एवं साइबर सुरक्षा क्षेत्र में अपने योगदान के लिए राष्ट्रपति सम्मान प्रदान किया।



सुरक्षा और एआई जैसे क्षेत्रों में उनकी लिंगी 9 पुरस्कार देश के प्रमुख संस्थानों जैसे आईआईटीएस और एनआईटीएस में संदर्भ सामग्री के रूप में पढ़ाई जा रही है। डॉ निलाक्षी जैन ने अब तक 70 से अधिक शोध पत्र प्रकाशित किए और उनके नाम पर 12 पेटेंट दर्ज हैं। उनके मार्गदर्शन में छात्रों ने राष्ट्रीय और अंतरराष्ट्रीय हैकथॉन, सीटीएफ प्रतियोगिताओं और स्टार्टअप में भाग लेकर लाखों के इनाम जीते हैं। कई छात्रों ने खुद के साइबर स्टार्टअप भी शुरू किए हैं। कंप्यूटर साइंस एंड इंजीनियरिंग विभागाध्यक्ष डॉ मयंक पटेल के अनुसार डॉ निलाक्षी ने आमी,

मेकैथी, एनजीओ और इंडस्ट्री के साथ मिलकर साइबर अवेयरनेस प्रोजेक्ट्स बटू केम्प और ग्रामीण अभियानों को संचालन किया है। नुकड़ नाटकों से अब तक 5000 से अधिक लोगों को साइबर अपराध और सुरक्षा के प्रति जागरूक किया है। डिजिटल इंडिया और विकसित भारत 2047 के सपनों को साकार करने के लिए नैतिक साइबर डिफेंडर्स तैयार करना उनके प्राथमिकता है। वित्त निवेशक और जगिड ने डॉ निलाक्षी को शुभकामनाएं देकर कहा छात्र एवं छात्राओं को इनमें प्रेरणा लेकर अपने भविष्य को उज्ज्वल बनाना चाहिए।

गिट्स में 24 घण्टे से चल रहे आन्तरिक स्मार्ट इण्डिया हैकथॉन का समापन

उदयपुर (वि.)। गौतमजी इंस्टिट्यूट ऑफ टेक्निकल स्टडीज (गिट्स) डब्लोक में केन्द्रीय मानव विकास मंत्रालय एवं ए.आई.सी.टी.ई. के संयुक्त तत्वाधान में चल रहे आन्तरिक स्मार्ट इण्डिया हैकथॉन का समापन हो गया। संस्थान के निदेशक डॉ. एस. एम. प्रसादकुमार ने बताया कि स्मार्ट इण्डिया हैकथॉन में देश भर के तकनीकी संस्थानों के विद्यार्थी अपनी अपनी रिसर्च के जरिये विभिन्न औद्योगिक संस्थानों के विकास में योगदान करते हैं तथा सामाजिक समस्याओं के निराकरण के लिए तकनीकी समाधान प्रदान करते हैं। यह एक देशव्यापी प्रतियोगिता है जिसका उद्देश्य नये इनोवेशन करना तथा तकनीकी समस्याओं के निदान के लिए टेक्नोलॉजी विकसित करना है। 24 घण्टे चलने वाले इस आन्तरिक हैकथॉन में गिट्स के विद्यार्थियों ने सॉफ्टवेयर आधारित प्रोबलम स्टेटमेंट पर 31 टीमों ने भाग लिया जिसमें 12 हाइवेयर की टीम तथा 19 सॉफ्टवेयर की टीम थी। इस हैकथॉन में प्रतिभागी गृह मंत्रालय,मिनिस्ट्री ऑफ़ कॉर्पोरेट अफेयर्स सामाजिक न्याय एवं अधिकारिता मंत्रालय राष्ट्रीय तकनीकी अनुसंधान संगठन और पंजाब सरकार जैसे राज्यों के बुनियादी समस्याओं का भी तकनीकी समाधान प्रस्तुत किया। एस.आई.एस. 2025 स्पीक डॉ. मयंक पटेल
